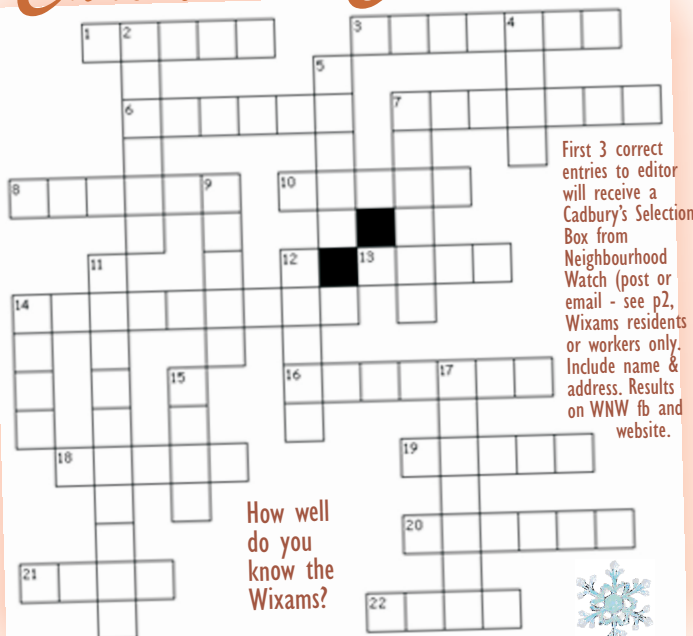

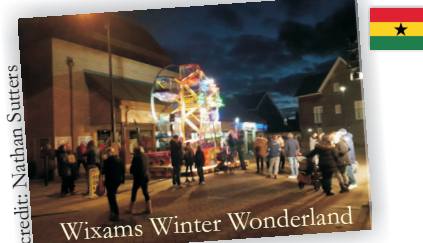

Job Vacancy Wixams Street Ranger

Wixams Parish Council is looking for an active, hardworking and conscientious person to carry out regular litter collection around Wixams Village including parks and recreational areas (but not including the 3G Courts), picking up litter from verges, flower beds, highways, footpaths etc using appropriate tools.

The normal hours of work will be 4-6 hours per week initially: to be reviewed in 6 months (there is room for negotiation regarding actual dates/times) and salary is likely to be £10.00 per hour.
