Let's start the year with a spring clean! Again I am not talking detox but hoping to improve your body's method of draining. If the drains in your house are blocked or congested your home will soon become an unpleasant place. It's the same with your Lymph system, your bodies drainpipes.

Councillor GRAEME COOMBES Reporting to Wixams - February 2016

1. Police Special Constables

Along with a Councillor colleague, I recently put forward a Council motion requesting Bedfordshire Police to recruit a Special Constable for each ward of the Borough. Special Constables are volunteers and the only costs would be for their training. They would serve exclusively within the area that they live and would only be deployed within their own ward and could not be taken away for other duties. I am pleased to say that this motion was passed unanimously by the Council.

2. Builders need to take more care

More than once in the last few weeks I have either seen for myself or been contacted by residents about mud, sand and other debris from builders, littering the roads around Wixams. I have therefore spoken to Planning Officers at the Borough, asking that, when planning consent is granted, adequate provision is made to ensure builders and developers clean up the roads. Dane Lane has been particularly badly affected and I am keen to see a very rapid improvement here.

3. Councillors Allowances

At January's full Council meeting I voted against an increase in Borough Councillors' Allowances. Whilst the proposal was only for a 1% increase, it seems wrong to me that Councillors should vote themselves a pay rise, particularly when the Council is likely to be shedding jobs this coming year. Sadly, others didn't see it that way and a majority of Councillors voted through their own pay rise.
