Wixams Parish Council cont ALLOTMENT UPDATE

The Parish Council wish to inform residents that the allotments will be ready and available shortly for use by residents of the community. It would be helpful for any resident to indicate if they would like an allotment, but also to select a plot size preference. Any names on the existing Lakeview Allotment Association list who have confirmed their expression of interest, do not need to take any action. However, of those that have applied it would be useful to know the size preference from the options set out below. Please note that at this stage these are just suggestions. Size A - I pole plot $(5m \times 5m)$ or could

Size A – I pole plot (5m x 5m) or could be shared as 2 half pole starter plots Size B - 2 pole plot (10m x 5m) Size C – 4 pole plot (20m x 5m or 10m x 10m)

As a guidance the amount of time per week maintenance as a minimum is 2 hours per two poles, excluding pre and post work.

This information will then allow the Parish Council to truly understand the exact level of interest within the community. If any residents would like more information or have specific questions on the allotment facility then they are welcome to attend the next Parish Council meeting on Monday 13th July at 7.30pm.
