What's the best food for swans?

V It definitely isn't bread. Their digestive system is not designed to metabolize refined flour, preservatives, yeast or refined sugar. If mouldy bread is fed to swans or ducks it can kill them. Bread is very convenient and clearly swans and ducks love it, but to maintain good health they have to eat a natural diet, or foods that are close to their natural diet.

Shredded lettuce, cast into the water, is a healthy food for most waterbirds.

CCTV

The Parish Council has taken the crime prevention initiative and installed cctv cameras on the only two entry/exit routes into Wixams. The system has the capability of recording in high definition every vehicle that enters and leaves Wixams, including the number plate. These images can then be accessed by the Borough control room and passed directly to the police. Similar systems have proved very successful in other villages, so anyone intending to commit a crime in Wixams should have second thoughts.
