Crimes reported in Wixams

In March 2016 fourteen crimes were reported in Wixams. These included burglary, theft, theft/interference with vehicle, two reports of criminal damage and nine reports of anti-social behaviour.

Crime stats

Due to Bedfordshire Police numbers being cut considerably, they will no longer be able to compile the crime figures or attend the Parish Council meetings to report on local crime.


