

Bedfordshire has the fourth worst gun crime statistics, fifth highest for robbery and burglary, and the seventh for knife crime

he Prime Minister took time to praise Bedfordshire Police for doing a "good job" of fighting crime while saving money, but the reality remains that the county has 169 officers per 100,000 people. The national police average is 232 officers for the same population levels and London has a ratio of 388 officers.

Police and Crime Commissioner Olly Martins has launched an online petition to get the issue debated in the Commons. He says: "This is not about the rights or wrongs of police funding cuts, it is about the fact that Bedfordshire Police is already the worst funded force in the country and is acutely under-resourced in the face of the policing threats it faces. The impact of further cuts to this already anaemic force will be high-risk not just for Bedfordshire but for national security."
